BIOS Packing List

Weather in Bermuda ranges from 60-75°F in winter to 75-90°F in summer. Bermuda is very humid and it rains frequently. We suggest light, breathable layers.

Travel Documents:

- Your passport
- Return airline ticket
- Bermuda visa, if required. Please check with BIOS Education Department for this information.
- Transit visa required for non-U.S./Canadian citizens traveling via the U.S.

Gear

- Water shoes / dive booties (need hard sole for sharp rocky shore)
- Rain jacket
- Beach towel
- Mask, fins and snorkel
- Knapsack or day-pack for transporting gear
- Re-usable water bottle
- Pocket flashlight (BIOS is not well lit at night)
- Dry bag

Clothing:

BIOS has laundry facilities that use quarters (\$2 wash, \$1.50 for drying)

- Jeans, shorts and shirts (it is recommended that you check the forecast before you arrive, www.weather.bm)
- Closed toed shoes and shower shoes
- Bathing suits
- Pajamas, underwear, socks etc.

Personal Items

- Sunscreen (no aerosol), hat, sunglasses
- Eye glasses or contacts (if you wear them, a spare pair is recommended as there is no optician near BIOS)
- Dramamine or motion-sickness patches
- Personal hygiene needs (toothpaste, deodorant, shampoo, razors, etc.)
- Pencils, pens, lab and note books
- Any special food and medications you might need during your stay
- Laptop computer and power cables
